**STEP I**

1. Register
2. Check Your Registration


**STEP II.**

1. Encourage someone else to register, check their registration.
2. Assist in getting people out to vote, talking to family, neighbors, friends and co-workers.
3. Volunteer, make calls, offer to provide transportation to the polls on election day and Souls to the Polls.
4. Encourage, young people 18 and above to register and vote.
5. Pray continuously for a fair election and election workers.

**STEP III**

VOTE early, in person on election day or by Absentee Ballot.

The power of the vote is your voice, let it be heard . "Do Something", be involved and engaged in this election.

You may register, check  your voting records and request an Absentee Ballot after Morning Worship. Someone will be available in the gallery every Sunday to assist you and answer your questions. You may also contact Mrs. Mertice Monroe.
